Visitation Policy Changes Effective August 16, 2021

Good news! We will be able to once again allow visitation. All residents and employees have tested negative for COVID two weeks in a row. You may begin calling Monday morning, 08/16/2021, in order to schedule a visit.

Fully Vaccinated Visitors

We will be allowing scheduled indoor visits for any family members and friends who have been fully vaccinated and the resident has been fully vaccinated. The number of visitors allowed at one time will be limited to 2 people per day. Fully vaccinated means that you have received the second shot in a two-shot series or one shot in a one-shot series <u>and</u> it has been 14 days since your final vaccination shot. Visitation hours will be from 8:15AM to 4:00PM seven days per week. You must provide evidence of vaccination before you will be allowed to make indoor visits. We will keep a log of those you are fully vaccinated so that you will only have to provide proof of vaccination once. These visits will require scheduling in advance. We will continue to schedule by phone, one week in advance. Please call the same number, (337) 427-0255. Calls will be returned in the order they are received.

Unvaccinated Visitors

Visitors who have <u>not</u> been fully vaccinated will continue to follow these guidelines:

- Outdoor visitation will be allowed. CDC still encourages outdoor visitation since it is the lower risk alternative.
- Visits will be scheduled for 30 minutes each visit.
- Visitation hours will begin at 8:15AM and the last visit will be scheduled for 4:00PM.
- Touching is discouraged, but will be allowed for short periods of time for those residents who so choose and only for residents that have received their second vaccination more than 14 days prior to the visit.
